ELIGIBILITY

The Awards are open to

- Journalists based in Hong Kong or Macau.
- Correspondents reporting in the Asian region.

Works must be

- In English or Chinese.
- Published or broadcast in the professional news media.
- Published or broadcast during the past calendar year, January 1 to December 31, 2014.
- Reported from the Asian region. We define this as Afghanistan in the West to Japan in the East, Mongolia in the North to Indonesia in the South. We include Central Asia, but not the Middle East. Works from Australia, New Zealand and the Pacific will be considered if they address broader Asian issues
- Related to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (<u>www.un.org/Overview/rights.html</u>).

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- We will accept no more than three (3) entries per journalist.
- Each work should have its own entry form. Please provide two (2) copies.
- We do accept series. See the individual category for details.
- English and Chinese forms can be downloaded as writeable PDFs from <u>HumanRightsPressAwards.org</u>.
- Photocopied or hand-filled forms are acceptable, so long as they are legible.
- Forms must include the number of the relevant article(s) of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights: www.un.org/Overview/rights.html. They must also include a summary of why the entrant feels the work deserves an Award.
- Label all additional materials clearly. Materials will not be returned.
- Mark the outside of the envelope "Human Rights Press Awards."
- The deadline is **January 9, 2015.**
- There is no entry fee.

JUDGING & AWARDS

Our three volunteer judging panels - English, Chinese and Photography - are comprised of leaders in the fields of journalism, academia, law and human rights.

Winners will be announced at our annual Awards Luncheon at the Foreign Correspondents' Club in April 2015. Short-listed candidates, plus their editors and producers, are welcome to attend.

Prizes are given to individual journalists, not media companies - with the exception of un-bylined opinion pieces. Plaques, certificates and prizes should go directly to the journalist. Companies can order duplicate plaques or certificates by emailing info@HumanRightsPressAwards.org.

CATEGORIES

TEXT & PRINT

This includes newspapers, magazines, journals, wire services and other text-based media.

Entries are divided into three categories

- Spot news
- Features
- Commentary

Provide two (2) copies of each article.

For a series of work, choose the top two (2) articles and provide a brief summary of the rest.

You may also include a URL or digital files like PDFs.

ONLINE

This category applies to

- online-only media.
- multimedia works that are best viewed as an online package and do not fit easily into a single traditional category.

Provide two (2) print-outs of the text / photos for reference.

A URL is required for this category.

CARTOONS & ILLUSTRATIONS

Provide two (2) paper copies of the cartoon or illustration.

You may also include a JPEG or other digital copies.

TELEVISION & VIDEO

We prefer DVD Video or MP4 video files on a data DVD. We also accept MediaPlayer or QuickTime files.

If the work is available online, please include a URL.

RADIO

We accept MP3 files.

If the work is available online, please include a URL.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Entries are divided into two categories

- Spot news
- Features

We accept JPEGs with a quality setting of eight (8) or above. They should be a minimum of 2,000 pixels on the short side. Include the credit and caption information in the metadata.

If you are submitting multiple photos on one disk, it may be helpful to also include the credits and captions on an MS Word file, clearly marking the JPEG file names.

You may provide print-outs or publication clips for reference.

For themed photo series, please send four to ten (4-10) images.
